

Google Bookmarks

The Bookmarks feature lets you save shortcuts to your favorite webpages and navigate to them in seconds. Unlike browser bookmarks that are stored on a single computer, Google bookmarks are stored in your Google Account. This means you can access them from any computer with an Internet connection from the Toolbar, the Google Bookmarks iGoogle gadget, or the Google Bookmarks homepage.


Scroll to the bottom of the Bookmarks homepage and drag the Google Bookmark icon to the Links toolbar

To Bookmark a Site

1. Click the Google Bookmark icon on the Links toolbar.
2. Fill in the form as desired and click **SAVE**

Import your browser's bookmarks or favorites into Google Bookmarks

1. Sign in to your Google Account by clicking the Toolbar's **SIGN IN**  button
2. Click the **Bookmarks** button drop-down menu, and select **IMPORT IE FAVORITES** or **IMPORT FIREFOX BOOKMARKS**
3. Select the checkboxes for the bookmarks you'd like to import
4. Click **IMPORT**
