


Google Bookmarks

The Bookmarks feature lets you save shortcuts to your favorite webpages and navigate to them in seconds. Unlike browser bookmarks that are stored on a single computer, Google bookmarks are stored in your Google Account. This means you can access them from any computer with an Internet connection from the Toolbar, the Google Bookmarks iGoogle gadget, or the Google Bookmarks homepage.

Save a site using the Google Toolbar

If you have the [Google Toolbar](#) installed, you can bookmark any site. Just click the star icon  on the Bookmarks Toolbar button. If you can't see the Bookmarks button, look for a chevron » button at the end of your Toolbar. Click the chevron to see your additional buttons.

Save a site in Google Web Search

To bookmark any search result, click  next to the link.

Save a site using the Bookmarks bookmarklet

Go to this site and drag the Google Bookmarks “bookmarklet” to your browser's bookmarks bar (<http://www.google.com/support/bookmarks/bin/answer.py?hl=en&answer=175117>)


Any time you visit a webpage that you want to save to your Google Bookmarks page, simply click the bookmarklet in the bookmarks bar. The page will be appear as a starred item on the Google Bookmarks home page.

Save a site directly to a list, using the Lists bookmarklet

Go to this site and drag the Add to List “bookmarklet” to your browser's bookmarks bar (<http://www.google.com/support/bookmarks/bin/answer.py?hl=en&answer=175117>)

Any time you visit a webpage that you want to save to a list, simply click the bookmarklet in the bookmarks bar. Click Select List and select the list you want, or click Create new List.

Import your browser's bookmarks or favorites into Google Bookmarks

Sign in to your Google Account by clicking Toolbar's Sign In  button.

Click the Bookmarks button drop-down menu, and select Import IE Favorites or Import Firefox Bookmarks.

Select the bookmarks you'd like to import, then click Import.
